Front matter: pages iii, xv, xiii (correction: forward to foreward) **Chapter 1:** page 2, col 1, the second sentence after the bulleted list should read *Type 2* diabetes is the most common form of diabetes. **Chapter 20:**

• Figure 20.1: "T6" which shows up in several places should be "TG".

• On p 631, under Pregnancy, Precautions, and Contraindications, "Statins are contraindicated in pregnancy" changed to "statins are not recommended in pregnancy."

• Figure 20.2:

Health Behaviors Management +

- BP \leq 20/10 mm Hg above target: One preferred anti-HTN agent
- BP >20/10 mmHg above target: Two preferred anti-HTN agents from complementary drug classes"

The fourth box from the top should read:

- "At target BP and therapy tolerated: continue therapy
- Not meeting BP target: Add preferred anti-HTN agent from complementary drug class
- Adverse effects: consider change to alternative preferred anti-HTN agent
- If not meeting BP target or adverse effect using drugs from each of 3 preferred anti-HTN classes, consider addition of mineralocorticoid receptor antagonist"

Footer should read:

- "*Preferred in albuminuria (UACR ≥ 30 mg/g)
- **Dihydropyridine calcium channel blocker
- ***Long-acting thiazide diuretics shown to reduce CVD events, such as indapamide or chlorthalidone, are preferred"
