If you have been a student of ours for a while, you may notice the survey below has changed. For 2024, the Commission of Dietetic Registration (CDR), one of our accreditors, has changed its guidelines for what feedback is collected to ensure materials follow its new Inclusion, Diversity, Equity, and Access (IDEA) initiative. The CDR describes IDEA as:

- CPE that promotes diversity and inclusion is developed and presented to recognize, respect, and include differences in ability, age, creed, culture, ethnicity, gender, gender identity, political affiliation, race, religion, sexual orientation, size, and socioeconomic characteristics.
- CPE that promotes equity and access acknowledges historical and institutional inequities.
- CPE is a safe space when approached with cultural humility and an openness to the cultivation of cultural competence. Beliefs, experiences, identities, and differences in abilities, age, size, socio-cultural / socioeconomic characteristics, and political affiliations are considered and respected.
