CDCES Exam

Hours Requirement

15 CE Hours - For the CDCES exam, a minimum of 15 clock hours of continuing education activities are required. These hours must be applicable to diabetes and received within two years of applying for certification. Since all of our programs are accredited by the CDR, our online and live courses fulfill the CE requirements.

1000 hours of Diabetes Care & Education -

Applicants must complete a minimum of 1000 hours of Diabetes Care & Education to sit for the CDCES exam. This practice hour requirement has been adjusted in consideration of the pandemic, to now required within the past 5 years, vs. within the past 4 years pre-pandemic

BC-ADM Exam

500 advanced clinical practice hours - To apply for the BC-ADM exam, you must complete 500 clinical practice hours within 48 months prior to applying for the certification exam. Clinical hours must be earned after relevant licensure and advanced degree was obtained.
