

7th Annual Becoming a Diabetes Educator Workshop

UCSF School of Nursing, UCSF School of Pharmacy, UCSF Medical Center, and Golden State Diabetes Network are teaming up with Diabetes Educational Services to offer this exciting training program. If you want to enter the dynamic and rewarding field of diabetes education and management, but aren't sure how to get started, attend this course to receive the foundation necessary for educating and managing patients with diabetes.

This program is designed for health care professionals (NPs, PAs, RDs, PharmDs, RNs, Case Managers, Social Workers,) who are interested in learning about educating and managing patients with diabetes. The first half of the program is primarily lecture and case studies describing the fundamentals of diabetes care and self-management. The second half of the program focuses on educational principles and behavior change strategies. This program is not designed as preparation for CDE exam.

First Week Topics Include:

- *Acute and Chronic Complications*
- *Medical Nutrition Therapy*
- *Medications—From Orals to Injections to Insulin*
- *Exercise Recommendations*



Second Weekend Topics Include:

- *Teaching and Learning Principles*
- *Behavioral Change and Psychosocial Assessment*
- *Special Populations: Child, Pregnant mother, Elderly*
- *Interactive Learning Stations and Role Playing*
