


FEATURES

REVIEW PROCESS

- o Documents and references are reviewed every two years for new information and updates are made.
- o If there is a significant update needed before the two year review it can be made at anytime.
- o Documents and references are reviewed by experts in the area, changes are made and a final review is done by the Executive Committee.
