Welcome to the Diabetes Ed Online University where you will find the content for your Online Course materials. Below is an overview of how our programs work and the intention behind how our courses are developed.

Types of Course Modules

- **Webcast** - If you are able to join the webcast webinar updates, join through the course's "Live Webinar" module.
- **Handouts & Resources** - Each course has its own handouts and resources module to supplement the webinar.
- **Recorded Webinar** - If you miss the live webinar update, you can review the recording in this module within 24 hours of the live webinar.

Types of Courses

- **CE Course** - In each course, our instructors highlight the critical content of each topic area so you can focus your study time most efficiently. In each **Live Webinar**, instructors launch multiple poll questions that highlight key concepts to help students assess their knowledge and learn the best test-taking strategies. Please note that if you watch the **Recorded Webinar & Podcast** the polls are not interactive.
- **Practice Test** - As you complete your courses, you may want to retake the tests to each course, especially if you are studying for certification. Our Practice Test courses are designed for you to retake the tests over and over again for courses you have already completed. Practice Tests are bundled by Level and course type.
- **Non-CE Course** - These courses are specialty topics that supplement CE Course materials.

All webcasts are recorded so attendance is not necessary to review content and earn CEs. The Recorded webinar is posted to the course in the Online University within 24 hours of the broadcast	After purchase, you have immediate access to your courses for 365 days (1 full year). Getting Started

- If you are enrolled in a course bundle with multiple levels, start with the lowest level first (e.g. start with Level 1 if you are in the CDCES Boot Camp or Level 2 if you are enrolled in the BC-ADM Boot Camp)
- If you are preparing for certification:
 - After completing each Level, take the "Practice Test" course for the Level to assess your knowledge.
 - Review any courses that go over the topics you scored lower on.
 - Repeat the same process by periodically taking the Test Taking Toolkit tests
- If you are not preparing for certification, feel free to skip the "Practice Tests" as they do not provide additional content or CEs.
